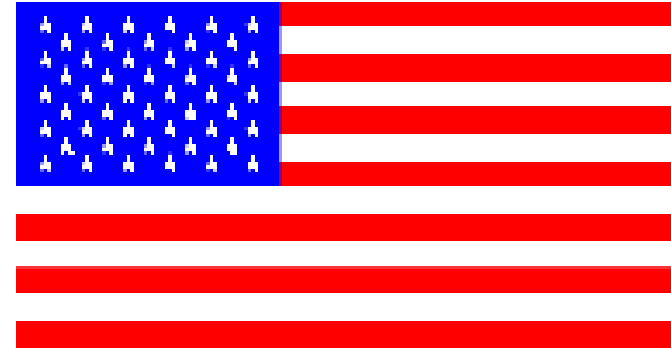
Band History

The Pawleys Island Concert Band was formed in July, 2004 following a short meeting of 13 interested musicians. Waccamaw Schools Director of Bands, Chris Graham, subsequently volunteered to conduct and graciously offered the rehearsal space of the high school band room, which was gladly accepted. The first performance was in December, 2004 .
