The Pawleys Island Concert Band is a community band located in Pawleys Island, South Carolina, USA.

The Pawleys Island Concert Band was formed in 2004 under the leadership of Bob and Bonnie Hawk as an all-volunteer musical outlet for adult musicians in the area. The band is under the direction of conductor Carson Turner, a veteran military musician. Assistant directors are Carl Brown, Bonnie Hawk and Jan Wurst. Members of the band come from all parts of Georgetown and Horry Counties.

Each year, the band provides a Christmas holiday concert, a Spring concert, and a 4th of July concert - all free to the public. In the past year, the band has also played at other commemorative functions and at the Lakes at Litchfield independent-living retirement community.

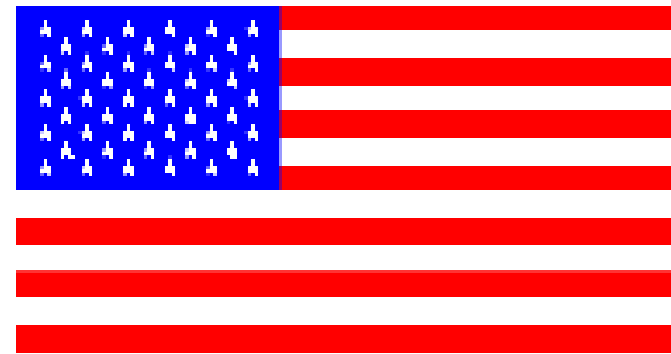
