The Pawleys Island Concert Band, under the direction of Carson Turner, is a community band located in Pawleys Island, South Carolina, USA.

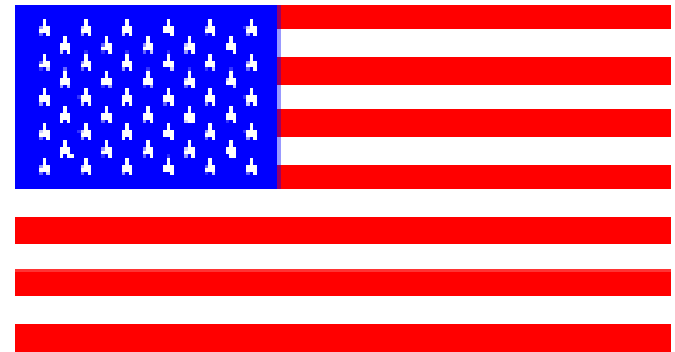
