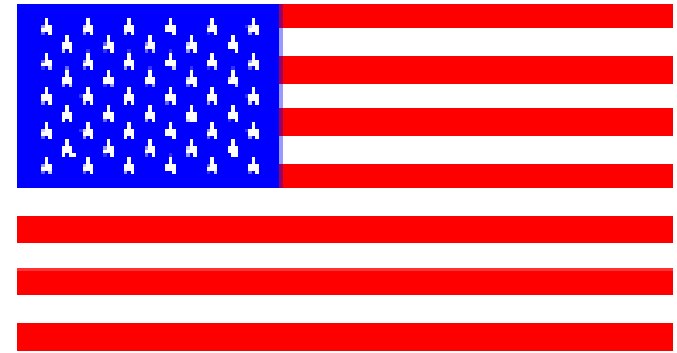

We are pleased to have with us this year the Choir of the Pawleys Island Presbyterian Church under the direction of Dr. Lana Stephens Pollard. The Choir and band have performed together several times in the past year. "Dr. Pollard (Lana) is a proud native of rural upstate South Carolina. She graduated from Presbyterian College in Clinton, SC and earned a Master of Music Education (Choral) at the University of South Carolina. From an early age, Lana has been deeply involved in all phases of music in a Presbyterian Church setting. She also taught music in public schools for a number of years, and was honored as Teacher of the Year at Carolina High School in Greenville, SC in 1986. She earned her Doctorate in Worship studies in 2009. Her Doctorate studies included the writing and performance of a children's musical, *Loyalty to Royalty: The Story of Ruth*, as well as a dissertation on using music to train children and youth as worship leaders."
