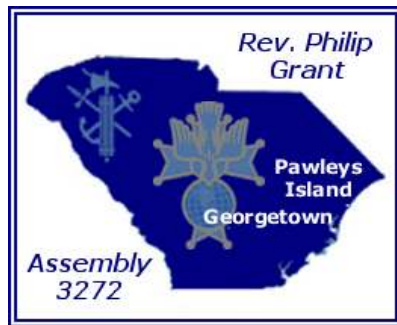

I. CALL TO ORDER
