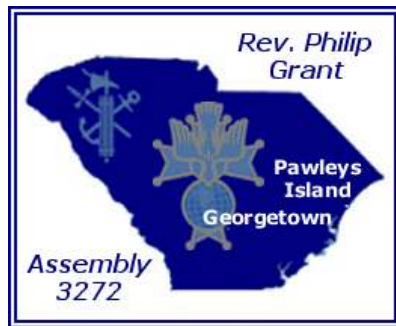

Assembly 3272 Business Meeting      November 29, 2018

The meeting started at 6:30 pm with a Hail Mary. There were 29 members present at the start of the meeting, but three more came for a grand tot of 32.
