#### **Georgetown Veterans Memorial Golf Tournament**

Thursday, August 19 will be the date of the Georgetown Veterans Memorial Golf Tournament.

The Georgetown County Memorial is located between the VFW Post 6444 and the American Legion Post 114 at 715 Church Street, Georgetown, SC 29440.

Those men and women of Georgetown County who made the supreme sacrifice from the Revolutionary War through the War on Terror are recognized on eight individual black granite stones. The memorial is approximately 90 feet long, with the two center stones approximately nine feet high. On the opposite side of each granite stone is a historic and graphic description of how those wars and conflicts affected Georgetown County during those respective periods. Between each granite stone, a flagpole stands tall with the United States flag leading, followed by the SC State, U.S. Services, and MIA flags.

The golf committee said they are well on their way but need more golfers to play.
