Worthy Sir Knights,

March is here and our eighth Newsletter of the Fraternal Year and third of the New Year. Today is Fat Tuesday the end of Mardi Gras and the beginning of Lent. With Ash Wednesday tomorrow we are reminded of our mortality as we begin 40 days of fasting and repentance. We are blessed with ashes on our foreheads and told "Remember that you are dust, and unto dust, you shall return," or "Turn away from sin and believe in the Gospel".

Ashes are a symbol of death and God formed humans out of dust. Without going into the prophesies of Fatima and Medjugorje, it is important we look at these prophesies and learn from them in this time of uncertainty. The unthinkable is now possible with a Nuclear war that would destroy man and God's creation. We must pray the rosary daily and pray always and everywhere now to avoid the unthinkable.
